**ATTENTION PARENTS OF STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN, SECOND, & SIXTH GRADES**

The state of Illinois passed a law effective July 1, 2005 that requires all students entering kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grades to have a dental exam.
